Dear President Spear:

It is my honor to inform you that I have received, approved, signed and deposited in the Office of the Secretary of State, Chapter 203, Senate File 1908 (with the exceptions of page 26, Article 1, section 2, lines 55 through 65 and page 27 lines 1-3).

I have line-item vetoed two transfers from the Department of Human Services to the attorney general for the purposes of a child support enforcement public education campaign and for consulting with the agency on the publication of names of certain child support obligees. The responsibility for child support enforcement activities rests solely with the Department of Human Services, and I believe that they are eminently capable of executing this function independent of the attorney general.
