Newcomer to Minnesota's house of representatives is Rodney N. Searle, Waseca county farmer.

Searle, 36, is a transplanted easterner who has plunged whole-heartedly into mid-west living. After graduating from high school in New Jersey he worked for a pharmaceutical firm at New Brunswick, N. J., and attended Rutgers university's night school sessions before migrating west.
