REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 118

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 16.125, the following administrative reorganization order is made with prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication of state government, certain powers and duties of the Department and Commissioner of Labor and Industry relating to the service of orders, decisions, and awards rendered by compensation judges are transferred to the Office of Administrative Hearings.

Transferred are the specific duties of serving copies upon every party in interest, together with a notification of the time the order, decision, or award was filed as described in Minnesota Statutes, Section 176.281 and to the extent necessary to effectuate the aforementioned.

No positions are transferred.

No moneys are transferred.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 16.125.

The effective date of this order is January 1, 1982. The order is herewith filed with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.
