Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 16.125 and 16.135 the following administrative reorganization is hereby made:

The authority to establish rules, regulations and procedures pertaining to deferred compensation per Minnesota Statutes, 1973 Supplement, Section 16.027, Subdivision 8(4), is hereby transferred from the Department of Administration to the Department of Personnel. Laws 1973, Chapter 507, centralize the administration of employee benefits within the Department of Personnel. As deferred compensation is construed as a fringe benefit, the administration of this program more appropriately belongs in that department.

No modification in regard to payroll deduction procedures or investment policy, now in effect, is intended by this order.
