

STATEMENT OF NEED AND REASONABLENESS
FOR PROPOSED RULE AMENDING 4 MCAR § 8.079

The Board of Barber Examiners has proposed certain amendments to 4 MCAR § 8.079, which sets the fees charged by the Board. These proposed rules will increase the examination fees by \$2.00; the annual shop renewal, change of ownership and change of location by \$15.00; the restoration penalty fee for apprentices by \$18.00; the restoration penalty fee for barbers by \$20.00; the restoration penalty fee for shop registrations by \$25.00; and the duplicate license by \$5.00.

These increases are necessary due to the increased cost of inspections, issuance and printing of licenses and the administrative costs.
