

Senate File No. 234. "An act to appropriate money for building an addition to the State Normal School building at Mankato, and a Normal Home for the use of the Normal school at Winona, and for completing the Normal Home of the State Normal School at St. Cloud" and other purposes.

The items appropriating money "For addition to the State Normal school building at Mankato the sum of Forty thousand dollars" (\$40,000) and "for the erection of a building for a Normal Home for the use of the students in the state normal school at Winona thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000)", Disapproved.

If the resources of the treasury would admit of it, I would be glad to approve these items, but with a probable deficiency of \$174,000 measured by the appropriations made, the necessity of restricting its obligations is manifest. The item of \$16,000 for the St. Cloud school being for completion of a partially constructed building, it is in the interest of economy to make the expenditure. I therefore approve all items of appropriation contained in this act except the two items first hereinbefore mentioned.
