RE: Yearly Listing of all Executed Design-Build Contracts

Minnesota Statutes 161.3428 requires the Commissioner of Transportation to submit to the Governor, chairs of the House of Representatives Ways and Means and Senate Finance Committees, the chairs of the House of Representatives and Senate committees with jurisdiction over transportation policy and finance, and the legislative reference library, a yearly listing of all executed design-build contracts. The report must identify the contractor, contract amount, duration, and services to be provided. The list and summary must be sorted by contractor; show the aggregate value of contracts, and state the termination date of each contract.

Since September 1, 2006, the Minnesota Department of Transportation executed only one design-build contract. The contract was awarded to Safety Signs for \$1,084,000.00. The contract is for assessing and replacing roadway signs along several highway corridors in Mn/DOT District 4. The final acceptance date for the contract is July 15, 2008.
