**SUBJECT: Report on Special Revenue Fund Agreements for FY 2009**

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 174.02 the following report is being submitted to the Governor and the Committee on Finance of the Senate and the Committee on Ways and Means of the House of Representatives for their information.

Five partnership agreements resulted in receipts totaling \$100,000 or more within FY 2009. A report is required to the Governor and Senate and House Committees on those partnerships, which are listed below:

Department of Natural Resources (DNR) \$ 377,110  
Mn/DOT will design, plan, maintain and repair radio communication for DNR.

NCDA/Met Council \$ 971,917  
Mn/DOT, together with Met Council, will provide the services of key personnel to assist in project management and oversight of the final design of commuter Rail facilities and the Light Rail Connection (LRT) to complete the design for the Northstar Corridor Rail Project.

Department of Public Safety (DPS) \$ 630,598  
Under Minnesota Statutes 299D.01, Subd. 8, Quarters, and 299D.03, Subd. 6 (in part), Minnesota Department of Transportation (DOT) is required to provide space for the Minnesota State Patrol and DPS has agreed to pay for such space in a shared facility.

Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED) \$ 155,250  
Minnesota Department of Transportation (DOT) will provide up to six internship opportunities for students with disabilities using the Mn/DOT Seeds model jointly with the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED).

Blanket Partnership Account \$ 2,221,436  
Bridge and Lab work for various counties and cities.  
9 of the 27 allotments over \$100,000

A letter reporting these agreements will be forwarded to the appropriate parties.

This legislation has attained its intended purpose of allowing the Department of Transportation to engage in projects, which increase the effectiveness of government and further the goal of increased government cooperation.
