WHEREAS: nearly 20 million people each year and costing the American healthcare system nearly \$16 billion in Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) have a devastating impact on our nation's health, infecting

direct medical costs; and

WHEREAS: and can be passed onto newborn babies, especially if they are not detected and treated early; and Many STIs do not show symptoms, but some have the potential to cause serious health problems

In the United States, young men and women have the highest rates of STI infections with about

half of new cases occurring among those aged 15 to 24 years, according to the Centers Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: A record 28,631 cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis were collectively reported to the

Minnesota Department of Health in 2016; and

WHEREAS: Communities struggling with social, economic, racial and health-related inequalities often have

limited access to STI testing and treatment services, resulting in higher infection rates particularly

youth of color; and

WHEREAS: The reduction of STIs will be achieved through concentrated and expanded opportunities to

detect and treat STI infections, especially by organizations that are representative of impacted

communities and equipped to address racial and health inequalities; and

WHEREAS: that reach Minnesota's most vulnerable communities through observance of an annual STI testing Community Restoring Urban Youth Sexual Health (CRUSH) promotes STI testing opportunities

WHEREAS: prevent STIs, get tested, and seek treatment if infected. During the observance, Minnesotans are encouraged to educate themselves about the ways to
