WHEREAS:	August 1, 2017, at 6:05 pm, marks the tenth anniversary of the Interstate 35W Bridge Collapse over the Mississippi River in Minneapolis; and
WHEREAS:	In this tragedy, 13 people were killed and 145 injured; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesotans have set aside this day to honor and remember the victims; to offer continued sympathy and support to impacted families and communities; and in further recognition and gratitude to police officers, fire and rescue personnel, and other first responders.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all U.S. flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff at all state and federal buildings in the State of Minnesota from sunrise until sunset on Tuesday, August 1, 2017, in observation of the Interstate 35W Bridge Collapse that occurred on Wednesday, August 1, 2007.
