Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota's park and trail system has grown since 1891 to include 67 state parks,

9 state recreation areas, 13 state trails, and 2 state forest campgrounds and day-

use areas; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota State Parks are wildly popular and receive more than 10 million

visitors each year; and

WHEREAS: State Parks are conveniently located across the state – within 30 miles of almost

all Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: Research shows that spending time in nature has many health benefits; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota State Parks offer a variety of year-round activities that families and

friends can enjoy together; and

WHEREAS: More than two-thirds of Minnesotans who visit a State Park make a return visit;

and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources will waive the State Park

entrance fee for Friday, November 24, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, November 24, 2017, as:

FREE PARK FRIDAY

in the State of Minnesota.
