Governor Dayton's Public Works Proposal to Deliver Clean, Affordable Water for Minnesotans

In 2017, Governor Mark Dayton worked with the Legislature to secure \$105.7 million in new funding for local water infrastructure projects through the Public Works Bill. This funding included \$88.7 million for grant programs aimed at improving infrastructure for drinking water, wastewater, and clean water in communities across Minnesota.

This new grant funding for local water infrastructure has already gone to work for 22 projects throughout Minnesota that are under construction or ready to start this spring. Another 39 potential projects are in line to access remaining funds from 2017. However, many communities continue to face challenges in keeping clean water affordable and accessible. At least 171 local projects will require additional funding to move forward this year, or in the years ahead.

That is why <u>Governor Dayton's 2018 Public Works proposal</u> would invest \$167 million to ensure more Minnesotans have access to clean, reliable, affordable water. That proposed investment includes \$142 million for grant programs to modernize Minnesota's aging clean water infrastructure in communities throughout Minnesota. Funding for Clean Water Infrastructure Across Minnesota

Local communities across Minnesota face high costs to repair or replace aging water infrastructure, which are often too expensive for city budgets to cover. Grant and loan programs from the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority (PFA) make it possible for local governments to fund the improvements necessary to ensure clean, affordable water for all their residents.

- **Grant Funds for Local Water Infrastructure** The Wastewater Infrastructure Funding (WIF) and Point Source Implementation Grant (PSIG) programs provide direct grants to local communities for infrastructure projects that improve aging wastewater and drinking water treatment systems, and to reduce additional pollutants entering Minnesota waters. Typically, local projects receiving WIF or PSIG grant funding can receive up to 80 percent of eligible costs. Governor Dayton secured \$88.7 million for these grants in the 2017 Public Works Bill, and has proposed a \$142 million investment in these programs this year.
- **Revolving Loans for Local Water Infrastructure** In addition to grant funding, the PFA can offer local governments in Minnesota low interest loans for local water infrastructure improvements. These loans can be used in conjunction with state and federal grants, to cover a community's share of project cost. Governor Dayton has

proposed a \$25 million investment to match federal funding and expand the loan program's capacity this year.

Projects Already Receiving Grants Under 2017 Public Works Bill

Thanks to the \$88.7 million in new clean water grant funding secured in the 2017 Public Works Bill, the following local water infrastructure projects, sorted by county, have been approved to receive new grant funding this year.

New Grant Investments Needed for Local Water Infrastructure

While the projects above may be funded under existing grant investments, the following projects in communities across Minnesota cannot proceed without additional investments in clean water infrastructure grants by the Legislature this year. That is why Governor Mark Dayton has proposed an additional \$167 million in his 2018 Public Works Bill to help fund clean water infrastructure projects. These local water projects – sorted by county – need new investments to keep clean water affordable and accessible to all Minnesotans.
